The United Nations Secretary-General is distressed at the mounting death toll in the violent two-day mutiny by members of the Bangladesh Rifles border guards. He condemns such brutal acts of violence and extends his deepest sympathies to the victims, to their families and to the people and Government of Bangladesh.

The Secretary-General calls for calm and the resolution of this situation without further violence.

The United Nations system in Bangladesh also extends its most profound sympathies to all those affected by these barbarous acts of violence, and to the people and Government of Bangladesh during this time of intense shock and unfathomable grief. We pray for the departed souls that they may rest in peace. And we hope that all will unite to help the recovery from this national tragedy in a spirit of peace and national oneness, for the greater good of the nation.
